


Sanskrit

Ayurveda originated as of Vedic sciences. All original texts of Ayurveda were written in sanskrit so, the knowledge of sanskrit language is compulsory to learn Ayurveda.

Rachana Sharir Department

Department of Rachana Sharir deals with the study of Structure of the Human Body including cadaveric dissection and topics like embryology, histology, Anthropometry, Genetics, marma sharer etc as per Ayurveda and Modern science.





Dravyaguna Vigyan Department

According to Charaka there is nothing on the earth which is not medicine. That's why Ayurveda considers all substances as medicine, if used for specific purposes in an appropriate way. It's a complete science of herbal plants. Ayurvedic drugs, especially herbs are prescribed in different pharmaceutical forms, to get maximum therapeutic effect.





Kriya Sharir Department

It deals with the normal function of human body and its parts. It emphasizes the concepts of Dosha, Dhatu and Malas, According to the Ayurveda every individual is unique entity and for knowing this uniquess of every individuals "prakriti parikshan" that is the analysis of body and mind is the speciality of this subject.

Rasashastra evam Bhaishajya Kalpana Department

Ayurvedic Pharmaceutics deals mainly with the drugs of herbal and mineral origin, their varieties, characteristics, processing techniques, properties, their therapeutic uses and procedure of any drug involve various steps starting from identification and collection of authentic raw material, application of standardized processing techniques and production of quality drug to packing and storage.



Swasthavritta and Yoga Department

Swasthvritta department deals with the total health or complete fitness; harmony at each level i.e. physical, physiological, psychological and spiritual of a human being.

The Swasthavritta OPD specialises in Diet, Lifestyle and Yoga consultation. The department is also dispensing its services in indoor department by regular diet advice for the admitted patients. Personalised yoga counselling for all conditions can also be availed from the Department OPD.

Rognidan evam Vikruti Vigyan Department

Rognidan and Vikruti Vigyan deals with the factors which are:

Essential to understand disease process as well as the diagnosis of disease.

The normal state of mind and body is called prakriti and the abnormal state of the mind and body is termed as Vikruti. Nidan Panchak is the base of diagnosis of disease.

The Knowledge gained by scrutinizing the causes and symptoms of a disease related to person is called Vikruti Vigyan.





Agadtantra evam Vidhi Vaidyaka Department

Deals with various natural and artificial toxic substances and poisons in detail along with their antidotes, signs and symptoms and legal aspects of medical ethics and standards.

Kaumarbhritya Department

Kaumarbhritya is one of the branch of Ayurveda dealing with the care of the child from the Conception to till the Maturity It is one of the Eight Branches (Astang) of Ayurveda.

It focuses on all aspects of nursing and healthy upbringing of newborns, infants and children by holistic approach for better progeny and society.



Prasuti Tantra Evam Striroga Department

Streeroga and prasuti tantra deals with management of diseases manifesting specially in women in every stage of life with gynaecological and obstetric care.

Panchakarma Department

Ayurveda has described the use of shaman (Palliative treatment) and Shodhan (Bio-Purifaction methods) methods. This Shodhan (Panchakarma) means five methods of body purification. These methods are employed in the healthy to prevent diseases and to improve the immunity as also in the sick to treat a number of diseases.

Kayachikitsa Department

Kayachikitsa is the first branch of Ashtang Ayurved that deals with general medicine, where kaya means body and chikitsa means treatment. Curing the disease can be attained through shaman (pacification) and shodhana (purification/detoxification) chikitsa, shaman chikitsa pacify the morbid doshas, where as shodhan expels the accumulated doshas.

Shalya Tantra Department

Department of Shalya Tantra (surgery) deals with the basics of surgery and para-surgical aspects given in Ayurveda as well as modern concepts at their level. The main focus of study is to get aware the students regarding the fundamental of surgical diseases, various disability and deformity, trauma, fractures, congenital and acquired illnesses etc.




Shalakya Tantra Department

Shalakyatantra deals with diagnosis and management of the diseases above the clavicle like Netra(Eye), Karna(Ear), Nasa(Nose), Mukha(Oral cavity) & Shira(Head).

Laboratory & Diagnostic area

The central clinical laboratory of UHAN is an advanced diagnostic Centre with all the modern equipments. This Central Clinical Laboratory (CCL) has Sample collection unit having cutting edge technology and incorporates the latest diagnostic techniques. Our Biochemistry section in the lab is equipped with fully automatic biochemistry analyser, Auto lab ESR machine, PSR+ Electrolyte Analyser, Ichroma Reader and Chamber, etc. The Hematological section for conducting relevant tests and the Microbiology section is also available to perform various bacteriological, etc. cultures. The Pathology section is equipped for urine, stool, etc. tests and has provision for cytological and Histopathological tests. The laboratory has a sample collection unit to collect the required samples, the laboratory is involved in conducting research oriented purpose for all the departments concerned as well as patient care. Radiological Department area has facilities like X Ray, USG, TMT, ECG and other such tools.







Herbal Garden

There are 450 types of verdant medicinal plants presently available in Herbal Garden especially for the purpose of study. A large part of College land is covered by this Herbal Garden.

Lecture Hall

Lecture hall is excellent for focusing the attention of a large group on a single point, either an instructor or an audiovisual presentation, and modern lecture hall often feature audio-visual equipment. With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act,1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. USTM/IAMC/Appl_NCISM/2022/482 dated 26.10.2022 received from The Registrar, University of Science & Technology, Techno City, Kling Road, Baridua, 9th Mile, Ri- Bhol, Meghalaya-793101 to verify the available facilities of teaching and practical training for intake capacity with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course from the academic session 2023-24, the college was visited on 21.09.2023 and 22.09.2023 on hybrid mode for issuance of LOI by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) and as per direction of competent authority letter of intent has been issued you vide letter of even no. dated 27.09.2023 to establish new Ayurveda college in the name of I.A. Ayurvedic Medical College, South Zone, Techno city, Kling Road, Bariduari-Bhoi, Meghalaya-793101, Guwahati, Assam (Inst. Id:- AYU0822) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under Section 29 of NCISM ACT 2020 from the academic session 2023-24.
- 2. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) had carried out an inspection of the institution again on 12.10.2023 & 13.10.2023 through Hybrid mode to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff and to verify the physical and other infrastructure facilities available for issuance of Letter of Permission (LOP) to establish new Ayurveda college in the name of I.A. Ayurvedic Medical College, South Zone, Techno city, Kling Road, Bariduari-Bhoi, Meghalaya-793101, Guwahati, Assam (Inst. Id:- AYU0822) with 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic section 2023-24 and relevant regulations thereunder.
- 3. Further, in view of above, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulation namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under.
